Youth Outreach

In cooperation with the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District our Youth Outreach Advocate makes age-appropriate presentations to area youth grades K-12.

Topics include: bullying prevention, teen dating violence, healthy relationships, sexual assault, conflict resolution and other relevant issues.

Community Awareness Workshop on Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault

Each April and October the Community Awareness Workshop is presented to those interested in learning how to combat domestic abuse/sexual assault in our community.

Information is provided by agency personnel, Office of Children's Services, Kenai District Attorney's office, Law Enforcement, Disability providers, and the Sexual Assault Response Team.

In Her Shoes—Living with Domestic Violence and other hands-on exercises are included in the curriculum, giving an

empathetic look into the lives of victims and survivors.

Continuing Education Credits (CEUs) may be applied for through Kenai Peninsula College for those who participate in CAW.

Weekly classes

Presented each week at LeeShore:

- *Changing Patterns*: an educational support group for women experiencing negative emotional patterns in their daily lives, which may be due to victimization (domestic violence/sexual assault) or substance abuse.
- *Parenting for Women*: an educational support group which focuses on child development, logical and non-violent consequences for behavior, and how to be a kind, yet firm parent.
- *Domestic Violence Support Group*: a group for women who are currently in an abusive relationship or who have experienced domestic violence in the past.
